

Grace Bible Camp Important Summer Camp Stuff to Remember

What to Bring:

- Bible
- Small notebook
- Bathing Suit
- Sunscreen
- Plenty of camp type clothes
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Pair of long pants
- Towel and washcloth
- Jacket, sweater, or sweatshirt
- Soap and shampoo
- Comb/brush
- Underwear and socks
- Sheets/blanket OR sleeping Bag
- 2-3 pair of shoes (1 tie up)
- Optional: Flashlight, camera

When and How to arrive:

- The camp week **begins on Sunday** and campers should plan to arrive **between 2 and 4 PM** to get checked in and to get settled into the cabin.
- The camp week **ends on Saturday**, and campers should plan to be picked up **between 10 AM and 12 Noon**.
